

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The Importance of Christian Education

Why is Christian Education important? Why is Cedar View Christian School, in my opinion, the best choice for Christian Education? I have experienced a unique perspective of CVCS. I was a student at CVCS from fourth grade through twelfth grade. I am a 1993 graduate of CVCS. I have been employed at CVCS for eighteen years as a teacher and coach. I have served in administration at CVCS for twelve years. I am also a parent of students at CVCS. I have been given the opportunity to witness CVCS from every angle possible. And so, what is my evaluation? Cedar View Christian School is a Christian school founded and maintained with the Word of God at its center. It is very strong academically with a challenging curriculum led by Godly teachers who are here to serve the Lord. This school has high standards where students are taught discipline and respect. This school equips students so that they can become servants of God. CVCS prepares its students to go on to college or the workplace and be productive citizens. I would like to give several reasons that your child needs what CVCS has to offer.

Looking back on my time as a student, there are several things that stand out in my mind. Intensive phonics is imperative. Reading opens the door to all learning. A struggling reader is a struggling student. At CVCS, students are given the proper foundation to be able to read well. Our kindergarten students are reading several grades ahead of other institutions by the end of the year. But it does not end there; students need a challenging reading program that reinforces what they have learned in five year old Kindergarten. Our elementary continues to stress phonics in first and second grades, and third through sixth grades focus on speed, comprehension, and vocabulary. Most elementary students read on a high school level. The other thing I am constantly reminded of from my days as a student at CVCS is how much one can learn when made to memorize. Yes, one needs to be able to think and reason, but one needs facts in his head to be able to do so. I learned Bible verses, catechisms, parts of speech, multiplication tables, dates, great people, terms, and scientific principles. Memorization is a key to knowledge. Most institutions replace hard work and memorization with computers and calculators. Students must be challenged in all grades so that they can reach their potential. As a graduate of CVCS, I was fully prepared for college and life. There are countless fellow graduates that received the same quality education.

Being a faculty member at CVCS has allowed me to get to know our caring and capable faculty. They love the Lord, and they love the students. What better environment could there be for a Christian young person? Our teachers challenge and instruct at a high level as they teach a demanding curriculum. CVCS is a family. And in a family, everyone looks out for one another. Teaching at CVCS is a ministry; it is not a job. That makes a tremendous difference in the life of the student.

Working in administration has opened my eyes to the strong and unwavering leadership that is needed to keep CVCS grounded in the Word of God. One can count on this school holding to

From the first Kindergarten class in 1970 to the current class of 2023, CVCS has offered the same successful program that has produced over 200 graduates who have excelled above and beyond the average. Our graduates score above the national average on the ACT test. In the last several years alone, we have students that scored 27, 29, 30, and 31 on the ACT. Many graduates receive academic scholarships at the best colleges and universities. The Lord has blessed this school for all these years, and we trust He will continue to bless it.

Finally, as a parent, I appreciate many things about CVCS. I have a place for my children to attend that reinforces the values that are being taught at home and at church. I know they are receiving the best possible education that is provided in this area. I don't have to be concerned with a wrong worldly philosophy infiltrating their minds. They won't be taught evolution, humanism, or a one-world philosophy as truth. Truth comes only from Jesus Christ and His Word. The only place to receive truth is in a setting with all subjects founded on the Word of God. I appreciate challenging academics with homework, high standards for dress and behavior, and a strong emphasis on memorizing and studying God's Word. I know the impact my education had on me, and I want that for my children.
